

Cornhole League Scoring System

- Points are tallied after all cornhole bags have been thrown in a round.

Bag outcome:	POINTS
Bag goes through the hole	3
Bag on the playing surface, hanging into the hole, or hanging off edge (not touching ground)	1
Bag touching the ground or resting on a ground-supported bag (unless removable without falling)	0

- The team with the higher round score adds the difference between team scores to their overall game score. Example: Team A scores 5, Team B scores 3 ---> Team A adds 2 points to their game total.

Game format:

- The home team listed on the schedule will start the match, and teams will alternate who starts each game thereafter.
- All matches are played as a best 3 out of 5 game series.
- Matches will be 1 hour long and will consist of games up to 21 points.
- Two players per team toss per game.
- Teams are allowed to alternate players between games.
- Match winner is determined by
 - Which team has won 3 out of 5 games.
 - Which team has won more games after the hour time limit.
 - If both teams have the same number of games won at the end of the one-hour time limit, the team with the higher total points in the current match will be declared the winner.
